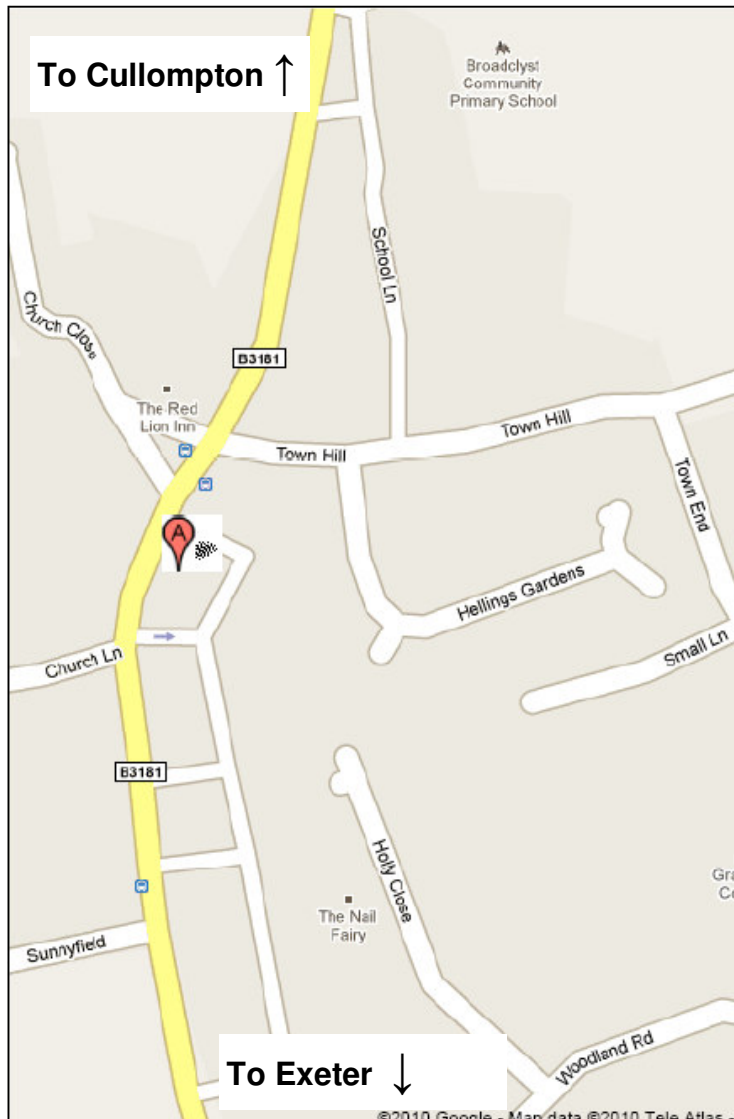

Directions to Broadclyst Victory Hall, EX5 3EE



From J28, M5 Cullompton (approx 8 miles)

Follow signs for town centre. At the traffic lights, turn left and follow signs for Padbrook Park. At the roundabout take the first exit onto the B3181 Exeter Road. When you reach Broadclyst, turn left into Town Hill, following the signs for Free Parking. Turn right towards Hellings Gardens, then right again. The Hall is on the right hand side as you drive into the car park.

From J29, M5 Exeter (approx 4 miles)

On leaving the M5, turn right onto the A3015 Honiton Road towards Exeter. At the first roundabout turn right onto Ambassador Drive. Go straight across 2 roundabouts. At the traffic lights turn right onto B3181 Pinhoe Road. Go straight across the 2 mini-roundabouts and follow the road to Broadclyst. When you reach Broadclyst, turn right opposite the Red Lion pub and church into Town Hill, following the signs for Free Parking. Turn right towards Hellings Gardens, then right again. The Hall is on the right hand side as you drive into the car park.

By Bus

1, 1A or 1B from Exeter or Tiverton Bus Stations (goes via Cullompton)
