### Easter Bank Holidays 2010

There will be no refuse, recycling or clinical collections on **Good Friday 2 April**.

Refuse, recycling and clinical waste will be collected instead on **Saturday 3 April**.

There will be no refuse, recycling or clinical collections on **Easter Monday 5 April**.

Collections will be one day later than usual throughout the week, with Friday's refuse, recycling and clinical waste being collected on **Saturday 10 April**.

### Items that East Devon District Council currently recycle at the kerbside:

- Magazines, newspapers, catalogues, directories (Incl. Yellow Pages).
- Envelopes, junk mail, office paper.
- Small amounts of shredded paper (carrier bag per collection).
- Glass bottles and jars (washed, no lids).
- Tins, cans and foil (washed, no sharp edges).
- Old clothes/textiles (which are not good enough for charity).
- Empty aerosol cans.
- Household batteries (bags provided on request).
