*29 **Minutes**

*31 **Application for Grant of an Annual Public Entertainment Licence**

Farenheit, 7 The Parade, Exmouth

The Sub-Committee gave consideration to a request to grant a provisional Annual Public Entertainment Licence for Farenheit, 7 The Parade, Exmouth

- RESOLVED** 1) that delegated authority be granted to the Licensing Manager to grant a provisional application for an Annual Public Entertainment Licence for Farenheit, 7 The Parade, Exmouth, Monday to Saturday 10.00am to 2.00am, Sunday 12 noon–1.00am and Sunday preceding a bank holiday 12 noon to 2.00am, subject to the receipt of the necessary documentation required at paragraph 1.4 of the report;
- 2) that the Fire Authority be consulted regarding concerns over steps for the disabled access at the rear of the premises.
