Any Premises Licence can be viewed through the Licensing Register on this website by returning to the Licensing front page and clicking on "Licensing Register" at the bottom of Quick Links on the right. On the next screen go to "Public Registers (Lic Act 2003)" and click on "Premises" to access a list of licensed premises. The listing is alphabetical. Find the premises you wish to view and click on the name. On the next page click on the licence number which will give you access to the current licence details.

**CONDITIONS OFFERED BY APPLICANT**

**a) General - all four licensing objectives**

- Make sure that all staff are trained and receive ongoing training as necessary to promote and maintain the four licensing objectives.

**b) The Prevention of Crime and Disorder**

- CCTV system with audio and real time recording and 30 day image retention in operation during all opening hours, with A4 warning signs that CCTV is in operation.
- An incident book recording refused alcohol sales and occurrences of disorder will be kept on the premises at all times.
- On granting of the licence I will become a member of the relevant licensing association.

**c) Public Safety**

- Not to offer any irresponsible drinks promotions.
- Make sure all staff are trained regarding legal and social obligations and their responsibilities regarding the sale of alcohol.

**d) The Prevention of Public Nuisance**

- Make sure that all staff are trained to discourage any behaviour that may cause a public nuisance.

**e) The Protection of Children from Harm**

- Make sure all staff are trained to implement the challenge 21 policy regarding the sale of alcohol.

**CONDITIONS OFFERED BY APPLICANT**

**a) General - all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e)**

- All staff to be kept aware of our legal responsibilities and policies, to maintain our reputation as responsible retailers and ensure a vigilant attitude to potential under age sales.

**b) The prevention of crime and disorder**

- An incident book must be maintained within which full details of all occurrences of disorder and refused alcohol sales at the premises must be recorded. The incident book must be kept on the premises at all times and must be made available for inspection by officers of both the Licensing Authority and the police.

**c) Public safety**

- The licence holder must ensure that all staff receive appropriate training regarding emergency and general safety precautions and procedures.
- The licence holder must ensure that all staff are aware of their social and legal obligations and their responsibilities regarding the sale of alcohol.
- An adequate and appropriate supply of First Aid equipment and materials must be available on the premises.

**d) The prevention of public nuisance**

- Due to the nature of our business we cannot foresee any public nuisance issues.

**e) The protection of children from harm**

- All staff must follow a proof of age policy. Anyone wishing to purchase alcohol who looks under the age of 21 must be challenged and asked for photographic ID.
- Customers ordering online must be required to enter their date of birth before purchase to prove that they are over 18 years of age.

- All parcels must be labelled to advise that it contains alcohol, and on delivery must not be left with anyone under the age of 18 years.
- All parcels sent out containing alcohol must be sent out by means of a 'signed delivery' and the person signing to accept delivery must be able to prove their age
