ACCESS TO LAND AND PROPERTY INFORMATION GUIDE (LLC, CON29R and CON29O SEARCHES)

SCHEDULE OF FEES
(Effective from 1st April 2011)

Introduction

East Devon District Council have produced this guidance for customers to enable them to request and carry out full property searches relating to Con29R, Con29O and Local Land Charge (LLC) data. If you have any specific concerns, comments or queries please contact one of the land charges team on 01395 571532.

Opening Hours/ Bookings

Our aim is to be open to all our customers and provide all information for the Con29 and Local Land Charges Register to personal searchers and members of the public in the same time scale as we provide our Official searches.

The Council offices are open from 8:30am to 5.00pm, Monday to Friday.

Booking a Personal Search of the Local Land Charges Register.

- Telephone the office on 01395 571532 to book an appointment for 11am, 2pm or 3pm (Mon-Fri) for up to 10 properties at a time.
- Send an email with a copy of the plan and address that you wish to search to lcharges@eastdevon.gov.uk at least 24hours in advance of your appointment.
- Arrive on the day of your appointment to reception and they will call us to collect you.

Booking Con29 Information

- Download Search booking form from www.eastdevon.gov.uk/land_charges
- Go to Personal Searches link on the right of the page
- Select ' A booking sheet can be downloaded from this link' Print off and complete relevant boxes on the booking form
- Check amount due and make cheque payable to East Devon District Council
- Attach a good quality plan of the property outlining in red the extent to be searched.
- Either post booking form/plan and cheque to Local Land Charges, East Devon District Council or leave with our reception desk team

- The search results will be emailed back to you as soon as possible.

Please remember it is important to note that any information received must not be used directly in compiling a search; it is the information you are purchasing in order to reply to the questions. If you wish to purchase an Official Council produced search, please submit both an LLC1 and Con29R Form.

Personal Search of the Local Land Charge Register in person

When arriving for your appointment, please report to Reception

While East Devon District Council staff will provide access to the relevant records kept in the form required by legislation, it is the responsibility of the person submitting the personal search to clearly outline the property to be searched.

You must take all the information you need for your search during your visit as you will need to book another appointment if you wish to look at the register again. Personal Searchers should therefore have some knowledge of Local Land Charges and/or governing legislation.

Further information will not be provided or questions answered about a personal search over the telephone. After you have completed your search, any further access to the Local Land Charges Register will require a new appointment for each search.

Information held on Public Registers – Some information relating to questions on the Con29R is available free of charge from statutory registers. If data is publicly available free of charge, the table that follows below gives details of where the information can be accessed. Alternatively, for a fee, Local Land Charges can do the work for you and extract the information on your behalf.

Information held on non public registers. If data is not publicly available it can be obtained for a fee from Local Land Charges via email. The Authority does not hold unrefined property search data; the equivalent refined data is made available on a cost recovery basis only in line with CLG's 'Local Authority Property Search Services – Costing and Charging Guidance'.

A pdf report extracted from our software, based on your search boundary, will be emailed when all enquiries have been answered.

You can ask questions singly or in any combination. Some data sets are held by Devon County Council and some Con29 questions will require data held by both East Devon District Council and Devon County Council. If you would like only information from Devon County Council please contact Devon County Council direct for details of data sets they hold by them. Information requested via East Devon District Council is automatically sent to Devon County Council. We offer this service as a convenient way of accessing all con29 data through our 'one stop shop' service.
