<b>EXPLANATORY NOTES</b>
If an Exclusive Right of Burial in a grave has been purchased from the District Council (or its predecessor(s) the written consent of the owner of that Exclusive Right is needed for the burial of any body, or for the burial of the ashes of any person, who is not the owner of the Exclusive Right. (If purchased, the Exclusive Right will be contained in a Deed of Grant which will normally be in the possession of the owner of the Exclusive Right.) However, such written consent is not necessary where the remains are of a person specified in the Deed of Grant, or in an endorsement thereon made at the request of the owner for the time being of the right, by the officer appointed for that purpose by the burial authority.
The Births and Deaths Registration Act 1926 required that before the burial can be effected a Certificate of the Registrar of Births and Deaths that the death had been registered or that he has received notice of the death or a Coroner's order for burial must be delivered to the Council.
<b>This application, together with the Registrars certificate and the relevant fees, must be delivered to Licensing Office, East Devon District Council, Knowle, Sidmouth, EX10 8HL at least 48 hours prior to the time appointed for interment.</b>
<b>Until this has been done, no arrangements for the interment will be made.</b>
